Milton's legacy of love, family, and quiet strength will live on through the many generations he leaves behind.

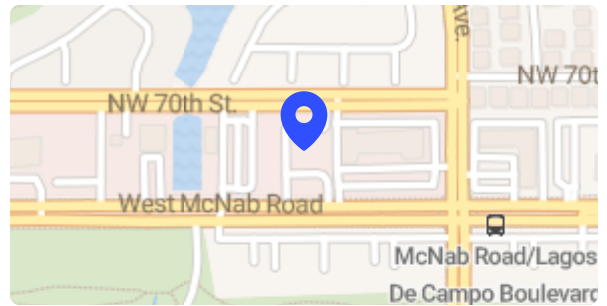
